If you've had two or three short stints, explain them candidly and be prepared to reassure employers about your long-term commitment.

5. Reflect on Your Goals Take time to understand your wants and needs for your next position. Be prepared to answer, "What does the ideal role look like for you?" Clarity about your priorities will help you target opportunities that align with your career path.

6. Follow Up Thoughtfully

There's a fine line between persistence and being overbearing. While following up demonstrates enthusiasm, sending multiple messages or emails daily can turn hiring managers off. Strike a balance by following up professionally and respectfully.

7. Embrace Positivity

A positive attitude is contagious. Regardless of how long your job search takes or any frustrations you encounter, remain optimistic. Negativity can raise red flags, while positivity signals resilience and confidence. Frame your experiences in a way that highlights growth and learning.
